Dear Dr Deubzer,

I attach our response to the questions you asked.


As time is short, our reply is in German, but an English translation follows.

In our initial application for prolonging the validity period of exemptions pursuant to Directive 2011/65 EU, what might be called "unfortunate wording" in Section 8, Para. 2 gave rise to a misunderstanding, which led you, in Question no. 6, to inquire about the manufacturers of PZT ceramics. In fact, our Section 8, Para. 2 referred to the users of hard PZT who incorporate these in their high-performance ultrasonic transducers.

Regardless of this, we have added to our list of appliance manufacturers/suppliers a list of such manufacturers of piezo ceramics as we are aware of.
