

Note on Yageo contribution regarding Exemption No. 7(c)-I

Exemption for „Electrical and electronic components containing lead in a glass or ceramic other than dielectric ceramic in capacitors, e.g. piezoelectronic devices, or in a glass or ceramic matrix compound“

Yageo Corporation have submitted a contribution concerning the assessment of the above-mentioned exemption. The contribution includes among others an application for the renewal of this exemption. Oeko-Institut would like to clarify that this document has been included as a contribution in the stakeholder consultation and not as an additional application for the renewal of the exemption.

As stated in the RoHS Directive, Article 5(3) applications *“for granting, renewing or revoking an exemption shall be made to the Commission in accordance with Annex V”*. The Oeko-Institut does not have a mandate to accept applications for exemptions as such.
