

JBCE comment on public consultation of [Exemption request 2014-2](#) “Lead in solders used to make electrical connections to temperature measurement sensors designed to be used periodically at temperature below -150C.”

*Dear RoHS exemption evaluation team,*

JBCE would like to highlight you that category 8&9 products can use exemption 7(a) in annex III for seven years from identified date when entry into force for each products, at the earliest July 2021.

Therefore we interpret that this, 7(a) covers the exemption in concept that common exemptions shall be listed in annex III.

Once 7(a) is justified that there is no need to use it for category 1-7, 10 and however it is needed for category 8 or 9 products, new or renewal application will be needed with justification.
